

So, you want to have an art show at Flemington DIY! *That is fantastic*. Here is what you need to know.

Step 1: Send us a proposal

Paypal/check accepted. *At this time, installation or 3-D works proposals will be considered on a case by case basis due to the high traffic nature of our community space. **Flemington DIY reserves the right to decline any proposal. Due to our being an all ages venue, artworks should also be suitable for all ages.



Opening Reception + Hosting Open Hours

- Artists are invited to host an opening reception event if they desire.
 - ➤ We recommend a weekend afternoon/evening for this event.
 - Light refreshments and snacks can be served (no alcohol).
 - > Flemington Shoprite often donates platters. Donation request form can be found here.
- Artists are invited to host "open gallery hours" throughout the month of their show.
 - This is a chance to open the gallery to the public, encourage visitors, etc. Flemington DIY is not open regular business hours; we are only open during scheduled events.
- These events are coordinated by the artist and not the responsibility of Flemington DIY.
- Check our <u>calendar</u> to see available dates. Email us to confirm the dates you would like to host these events.

Step 2: Promoting your show

You need to promote your show so people come to it!

Create a flyer so we can help promote it. Canva.com is a great place to create flyers if you need help.
Flemington DIY will build out a website page on our website featuring the show.
Send a press release to all local papers.
Create a Facebook event (add DIY as a co-host)
Create an event on Hunterdon Happening and Tap Into Flemington.
Submit event to Love Flemington Community Calendar
Share event on all the socials (collaborative posts are a great idea)
Hang flyers at your local haunts.
Personally reach out to people to invite them.
Reach out to local arts organizations
Create a 1 page description of the show to include in gallery



Additional Details & Considerations

Our hanging system

- ➤ We use the <u>STATS hanging system</u>. Click link to learn more about it. We use this system to maintain our walls. **Your work will need to be wired to hang.**
- ➤ We have about 25 wires with hooks that can host up to about 100 works.
- > We recommend creating labels for art pieces.

* Insurance for your work is recommended but not mandatory, as Flemington DIY will not be held responsible for any damage to work. Keep in mind this is a community space with many different groups coming in and out for programs/events.

❖ Selling Your Art

- Artists may sell their work if they choose to do so. Flemington DIY does not charge commission.
- All transactions are strictly handled between artist and buyers.
- ➤ You may include payment information, such as QR codes or your contact information, within your 1 page description of the show. Explain art buying procedures in this document.
 - Determine if delivery of work will occur at time of purchase or at the conclusion of the show.

Closing your show

- > Remove all your work by the time on your contract.
- > Any work left after your contract date will be donated to Flemington DIY.
- ➤ If any scratches or blemishes have occurred due to your show, please repair the walls with our supplies of patch and paint. A final walkthrough may be conducted with a DIY volunteer.
- ➤ Please let us know if you need repair supplies or you came across any other issues when closing your show.
